WALKING TOUR

BARN QUILTS AND HIDDEN HISTORY MURALS OF MARQUETTE COUNTY

1. Oxford Elementary School – 222 S. Franklin Avenue
Several murals are in the gymnasium and available to view all day. They were created by Oxford elementary children with the guidance of muralists Tim and Connie Friesen. More of these murals can be found in the cafeteria.
2. Oxford Village Hall – 129 S. Franklin Avenue.
From the school, walk 1 block north on Franklin Ave to the Village Hall building on your left. Go inside to the community room (in the back) to view murals created by older and younger youth with muralists Connie and Tim Friesen. Mural C Hands All Around is dedicate to youth and adults as partners in civic leadership.
3. Oxford Library – 129 S. Franklin Avenue
Outside, located on the north side of the library is Barn Quilt #30 Knowledge, developed by the Friends of the Library.
4. Drops of Kindness – 136 W. Ormsby Street (Hwy 82)
From the library, walk ½ block to Ormsby St (Hwy 82) and turn left. Walk ½ block to Drops of Kindness to find Mural W Oxford Spirit, located on the east side of the building. Painted by artist Jill Bachmann, who used to co-own this building when it was Sky Blue Dreams.
5. Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative – 113 N. Oxford St.
Now walk ½ block further west to Oxford St. and turn right. Mural Y Historic Telephone Company is on Marquette-Adams Telephone Cooperative. It's a beauty!
6. Up North Hunting – Go back to Hwy 82 and turn LEFT walking back toward downtown Oxford. At the end of the block at 126 W. Ormsby you'll see United Country Real Estate building. Inside is Mural Z Up North Hunting, also painted by artist Jill Bachmann.
